Program Duration

This is program runs from September the following December (i.e. Sept 2016-Dec 2017).

There are one-week breaks between courses, and no classes over the summer (July-August).

Eligibility Requirements

General PACE, eligibility (grade 12) plus at least 2-years of career development related work experience.

Program Requirements

Required Courses (270 hours)

• Career Development and Counselling Theories

Students will gain an informed foundation and theoretical context for their career development practice.

• Career Development and Counselling Process

This course builds core skills and specialized counselling techniques needed to effectively build a working alliance with clients and deliver employment-counselling services.

• Assessment Instruments

Students will gain hands-on experience with a range of standardized and nonstandardized assessment approaches and tools.

Work Search

Students will learn how to assess work search needs and support the work search process.

- Ethical Practice in Career Development Students will gain the theoretical and reflective foundation necessary for ethical service delivery.
- Career Development and Counselling Challenges

Students will gain the core skills and knowledge needed to effectively respond to common challenges in the delivery of client services.

- Facilitating Client Learning Students will gain the knowledge, skills, tools and techniques they need to effectively help their clients learn.
- Using Labour Market Information in Employment Counselling

This course prepares students to better access, understand and apply labour market information (LMI) in their work with clients.

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
