BUSINESS SYSTEMS ANALYST DIPLOMA PROGRAM

In all industries businesses rely on information. Quality, timeliness of data, and complete analysis can impact critical decisions. The role of a Business Systems Analyst is to bridge the gap between the business' need for that information and available solutions. The analyst builds this bridge by thoroughly analyzing the business' needs and processes and then designs and tests a solution.

The program consists of two components: the required courses and Professional Edge Seminars.
