Winnipeg is the capital city of Manitoba and located in the centre of Canada, which is consistently ranked one of the world's safest countries and one of the world's top travel destinations.


Our central downtown campus is only steps away from exciting nightlife, galleries, museums, and shopping, as well as being close to green spaces, parks, and walkways.
