## HEART OF CANADA

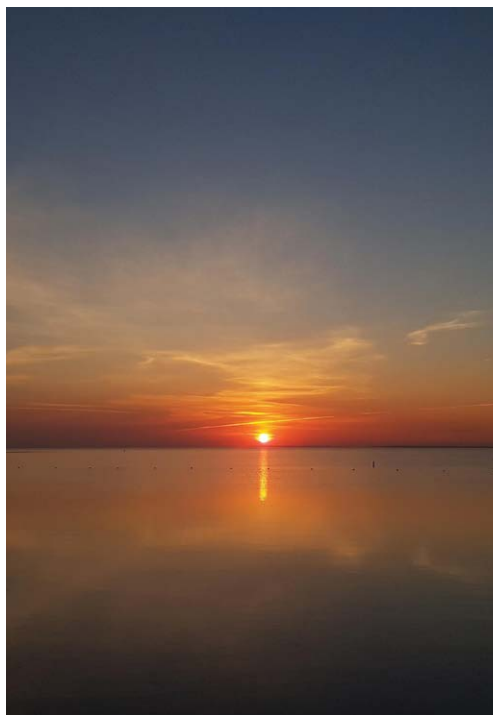
