



PACE Accepted Transfer Credit Chart

Subject to Conditions:

- 1) Final grade must be the PACE equivalent of "C+" (66%) or higher
- 2) Transfer credit cannot exceed program residency requirement
- 3) Original transcript is required
- 4) Courses must be current within five years (some exceptions apply)
- 5) ICT courses must be current within two years (some exceptions apply)
- 6) Transfer credit is only assessed for PACE programs and does not guarantee transfer credit to other UWinnipeg faculties or post-secondary institutions.
