

COURSES

» Risk Management Principles & Practices*

The course focuses on the principles and practices that form the foundations of risk management. The course will prove an understanding of the risk management environment and expectations within an organization. There will be a detailed study of the best practices for identifying, assessing and dealing with an organization's risk.

» Risk Assessment & Treatment

The course provides students with a comprehensive overview of the techniques and measures available to control the risks from property, personnel, liability and net income loss exposures. Subjects treated include, choosing the best risk control techniques and measures, system safety analysis, and staff motivational theories for effective implementation of risk control measures.

» Risk Financing

Students gain a broad understanding of the concepts of risk financing. The course covers a wide range of topics (e.g. insurance, claims, forecasting, cost allocation), each of which requires its own high level of expertise. By the end of the course students will understand the general concepts to be able to work with the experts in the each of these disciplines to fashion sound risk financing programs.

*Although the Risk Management Principles & Practices course is recommended as a prequisite for Risk Assessment & Treatment and Risk Financing courses, dependant on experience in the insurance, legal, or engineering realms, students may take the courses in any order.

WHY RISK MANAGEMENT?



The Canadian Risk Management (CRM) designation is a widely recognized qualification that provides risk managers a foundation of knowledge and skills needed to identify, assess, monitor, and limit risks.



The CRM is recognized by the Risk and Insurance Management Society (RIMS) and awarded by the Global Risk Management Institute (GRMI).



Once you have completed the three foundational courses and passed standardized exams for each course, administered separately by GRMI to verify that CRM candidates possess a consistent level of knowledge.

Canadian Risk Management is recognized by the Risk and Insurance Management Society (RIMS) and awarded by the Global Risk Management Institute (GRMI). Graduates must register for the GRMI standardized test to complete their certification process.
